CREDENTIALS GUIDELINES

In order to be eligible to request clinical privileges for hematology/oncology, a practitioner must meet the following minimum threshold criteria:

EDUCATION: MD or DO

MINIMUM FORMAL TRAINING: The applicant must be able to demonstrate successful completion of an accredited residency in internal medicine, followed by completion of a two-year formal fellowship in oncology or hematology.

BOARD CERTIFICATION: The applicant must meet the Medical Staff Bylaws requirements for board certification.

**IF YOU MEET THE ABOVE CRITERIA, YOU MAY REQUEST CORE PRIVILEGES IN
HEMATOLOGY/ONCOLOGY.**

REAPPOINTMENT CRITERIA

Should be based on:

- Unbiased, objective results of care according to the organization's existing quality assurance mechanisms;
- Demonstrated competence by showing evidence of care to at least twenty (20) patients annually; and
- Successful completion of continuing medical education requirements that relate to hematology or oncology.

<p>Admit, evaluate, diagnose, treat, and provide consultation to patients of all ages, except as specifically excluded from practice, with all types of cancer and other benign and malignant tumors. Privileges include but are not limited to</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Bone marrow biopsy and interpretation • Diagnostic lumbar puncture • Administration of chemotherapeutic agents and biological response modifiers through all therapeutic routes • Management and maintenance of indwelling venous access catheters • Perform waived laboratory testing not requiring an instrument, including but not limited to fecal occult blood, urine dipstick, and vaginal pH by paper methods. • Therapeutic thoracentesis and paracentesis
